The history of Pride month is widely accepted to have begun in 1969 with the Stonewall Riots in New York City. This was a series of protests led by the LGBTQ community in response to police violence targeting members of the community. In 1999, "Gay and Lesbian Pride Month" began to be nationally recognized by the US government. In 2011 that recognition was officially expanded to include the entirety of the Queer Community. Pride is celebrated throughout many cities and communities throughout the country and generally recognized with festivals, block parties, and parades.
